COVID-19 Safety Plan January 2022

Conditions of entry into LJ/50s are

- You are not suffering from flu-like symptoms, are not required to be in self-isolation or are not a close contact of a person who is required to be in self-isolation.
- Maintain physical distancing (1.5m) at all times, if possible, both inside & outside the club's premises.
- Wear a mask at all times, unless engaged in a strenuous physical activity
- Contact details will be collected at entry & these will be made available to the Dept of Health, in the required format, on request, within the required time frame.
- Visitors and members to use Service NSW QR code if possible
- Use of hand sanitisation on entry, & as often as is necessary, while in the club

Hygiene & Cleaning

- Personal – hand sanitisers (available in all work & activity areas). Appropriate signage in place
- Premises – cleaning & disinfection of all touch points throughout facility once daily
- Cleaning product available in all activity areas

Information

- COVID 19 Information, LJ/50's COVID Safety Plan on display
- Product Information in resource boxes located in activity areas

Signage

- Appropriate signage will be in place throughout premises

Food Handling

- Morning/afternoon tea available in activity areas
- Members may prefer to bring own water, thermos, mugs

Action Plan is in place if an active case is identified associated with club

- Club closed for 72 hrs, if requested to do so, then cleaned before re-opening
